Cross mending

Jigsaw: Ceramics

You're an archaeologist on a dig and you find a pile of broken ceramics!

You clean them up in the lab and see some of the pieces fit together.

Cross mending is the process of *fitting together pieces of an object*.

You can practice cross mending by coloring, cutting along the dashed lines, and then mixing the cut pieces to try to make it whole again!
